

6 Early Bird Cut Off Date is When?	<p>During Week:</p> <p>Sunday:</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Phone blitz to every man in the church asking, "Have you signed up yet?" Early bird discount ends this coming Sunday.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Pastor to endorse upcoming PK event and challenge men to visit the info table and sign up today.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Use Power Point slides in announcements</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Man the sign up table and have volunteers with clipboards and sign up forms approach men in the hallways to sign them up.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Go online and purchase the registrations you require (if using one CC to order the wristbands).</p>
4	<p>During week:</p> <p>Sunday:</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Meet as a team to pray for the men in your group who are already attending and build a list of up to 5 men each member on the team can personally invite to attend (from your church or from work, community, family, etc.)</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Begin to plan for follow up after the event – ideas include: a Men's Breakfast for men to share a testimony, a 6 week Men's Group using PK's Group Study material, or a work project for the men to put their faith into action.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Email the men who have not registered and remind them that they can still register for a reduced rate and let them know about the men from your group already planning to attend and how they don't want to miss that fellowship.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Man the Information Table and connect with men as they walk by.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Make an announcement or put an announcement in the bulletin inviting the women to help out with their prayers and to volunteer at the conference. 3	<p>During Week:</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Personally phone or visit with the 5 men you have agreed to personally invite to attend the conference and work with them to register for the event.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Man the Information Table and connect with men as they walk by.</p>
2	<p>Sunday</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Make an announcement or put an announcement in the bulletin reminding people that the next registration cut off date is coming up quickly and they can still save some finances by registering today.</p>
1	<p>During Week:</p> <p>Sunday:</p> <p>Monday:</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Email men: "It's not too late to join us!"</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Church Bulletin Insert copied and put in church bulletin</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Highlight for men that this is the last Sunday to sign up.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Continue collecting names and payment on clipboard list.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Go online and register all unregistered men and make payment. These men will need to pick up their registration wristbands at the registration desk at the event.</p>

Other Ideas:

- Some churches make the PK event a whole weekend for their men. They book hotel rooms for Friday and Saturday night. After the event is complete on Saturday afternoon, they will spend time doing a fun activity together (attend a sporting event, playing video games, etc.) and also intentionally spend the rest of their time in fellowship and discussion of what God was saying to them during the conference.
- Traveling together to the event provides the opportunity for fellowship – as much as possible, help men experience the event together.
- Follow up is a key part of an event having impact. Many men's small groups, prayer groups, missions teams, etc. have been formed as a result of the friendships forged during a weekend away at a PK conference. Visit www.promisekeepers.ca for small group study guides for men.
